What is Cancer Voices NSW?

Cancer Voices NSW is the peak cancer advocacy organisation providing the independent voice of people affected by cancer in our state and beyond.

Members include people with cancer, cancer survivors, carers, cancer care professionals, interested individuals and organisations. We aim to represent the needs of the over 50,000 people who are diagnosed with cancer in NSW every year.

As a collaborative network, Cancer Voices NSW provides a forum for those affected by cancer to share their concerns, ideas and experiences.

Our representatives present broad, informed views on cancer issues at local, state and national levels.

Cancer Voices was established in 2000 and since then has been influential in improving cancer care, information, support and research in NSW and beyond.

Who are we?

We are all volunteers from a diversity of backgrounds, locations and age groups. Many of us have experienced at least one or more of the wide range of cancers and treatments. We all work to make a positive difference to the cancer experience for others.

- Run and support programs: consumer representation; Consumer Involvement in Research; provide an efficient matching process for cancer stakeholders, including researchers, with trained consumer representatives
- Manage the Consumers Included logo program
- Develop and publish Cancer Voices Position Statements on our website
- Communicate with our members and stakeholders via our newsletter, website and social media
- Work closely with cancer and other consumer health organisations across Australia
